The Gentile Pentecost

Acts 10:1-11:18

- In 1989 the Berlin Wall was destroyed and the Eastern and Western halves of a divided Germany were reunified
- Today we will see God's grace in demolishing another wall in order to prepare the way for the Gentile mission

I. Preparation of Cornelius (10:1-8)

- 1) Who was Cornelius?
 - a. A Roman Centurion (cf. Luke 7:1-10)
 - b. Stationed in a city of influence
 - c. A devout and generous 'God-fearer'
- 2) The Vision from God
 - a. God didn't send Philip (cf. Acts 8:40)
 - b. God didn't communicate the gospel directly through the angelic vision
 - c. God chose to send His Apostle on a groundbreaking mission to the Gentiles!
- 3) God's sovereign work of preparation in a person's heart usually begins long before the moment of conversion

II. Preparation of Peter (10:9-23)

- 1) Demolishing the Dividing Wall
 - a. Jewish laws and cultural traditions were the biggest hindrance to the Gentile mission
 - b. God often challenges the Evangelist before He challenges the Non-believer!
 - c. Peter's actions in chapter 10 are remarkable for a devout Jewish man

- i. He resides in the house of an 'unclean' tanner (9:43)
- ii. He extends hospitality to Gentiles (10:23)
- 2) What cultural barriers will we need to challenge as we seek to fulfill the Great Commission in our generation?

III. Preparation of the Gentiles (10:24-48)

- 1) Peter was expecting one man, but God had prepared a crowd of eager listeners
- 2) Faith comes by hearing
 - a. Peter keeps the focus of his sermon on Jesus
 - b. Cornelius was not accepted by God apart from personal faith in Christ
 - c. The Spirit falls on the Gentiles while the sermon is being preached!
- 3) Peter witnesses the 'Gentile Pentecost'
 - a. Eager men and women gathered in a house just as in Jerusalem (cf. 11:15)
 - b. Supernatural sign of tongues given as evidence of Spirit Baptism

IV. Preparation of the Church (11:1-18)

- 1) Peter's actions in Joppa were sharply criticized by his fellow Jews
- 2) God eased the Cultural Shock in two ways:
 - a. Provided 6 Jewish witnesses in addition to Peter's testimony (v. 12)
 - b. Manifestation of tongues provided compelling evidence of God's unfolding plan in a unique historical situation
- 3) Effective missionary work requires us to identify prejudice and cross cultural boundaries!
