### **The Early Church in Action**

Acts 20:1-12

- These few verses in Luke's narrative cover approximately 1 year of Paul's Third Missionary Journey! During this time Paul re-visited the Churches of Macedonia and Greece which he had planted on the Second Missionary Journey. The Epistles of 2 Corinthians and Romans were both written during this time and give us further insight into the details of his missionary activity.

- Although we must be careful about drawing doctrine from narrative (descriptive) passages, these verses help us to understand a few central priorities within the Early Church (cf. Ac 2:42-47)

### I. Generosity (vv. 1-4)

- 1) The Jerusalem Collection:
  - a. One of the crowning achievements of Paul's ministry which is underappreciated!
  - b. Mentioned in Acts 19:22, Romans 15:25-26, 1 Corinthians 16:1, 2 Corinthians 8-9)
  - c. Intended to ease the burden of the poor and persecuted Jewish believers in Jerusalem.
- 2) A Pattern of Generosity:
  - a. A top concern for Paul's ministry
    - i. Agreement with Apostles (Gal 2:9-10)
    - ii. Paul's hesitance to place a financial burden on the Church (Acts 20:33-35)
  - b. A top concern for Luke's writing of Acts
    - i. Selling of personal property (Acts 2:44-45, 4:34-37)
    - ii. Consequences of greed (Acts 5:1-11)
    - iii. Famine relief (Acts 11:27-30)

**Application**: A concern for us today?? Do our financial priorities reflect the generosity and

priorities of God? Do we love the brethren in both word and deed? (cf. James 2:14-17; 1 John 3:18)

### II. Camaraderie (vv. 2-6)

- 1) Ulterior motive for the Collection
  - a. Relations between Jewish and Gentile Christians in the Early Church were tense because of cultural differences
  - b. Paul hoped that the love and generosity of the Gentiles would help ease these tensions
- 2) A Display of Gospel Solidarity
  - a. The messengers mentioned by name and region in v. 4 accompanied Paul to Jerusalem as a visible expression of Church Unity!
  - b. Paul's persistence in "encouraging" the churches also underscores the camaraderie that existed within the Early Church

**Application:** Do we see other Churches and Missions as 'comrades' in the Gospel or as 'competitors'?

### **III. Worship (vv. 7-12)**

- 1) A Designated Day for Worship:
  - a. Early Christians met on Sunday instead of Saturday (cf. 1 Cor 16:1-2)
  - b. Jesus rose from the dead, and the Spirit was poured out on the first day of the week
  - c. Sunday is not a replacement of the Sabbath! (cf. Col 2:16-17; Gal 4:10-11; Rom 14:5-6)
- 2) The Lord's Supper:
  - a. Observed during a communal meal called the 'Love Feast' (cf. Acts 2:42; 1 Cor 11:17-34)
  - b. Observed weekly in the Early Church!
- 3) Preaching:
  - a. Church's insatiable hunger for God's Word
  - b. Paul's delight in preaching
