Instructions for Leaders

Acts 20:13-38

- Acts 20 records Paul's farewell message to the Elders of the Ephesian Church. This is the only recorded sermon in the book of Acts which Paul addressed to a Christian audience
- Paul's sermon to the Church Leaders in Ephesus breaks down into two parts: 1) Paul's Example; 2) Paul's Exhortation

I. Paul's Example (vv. 17-27; 33-35)

- 1) Serving with Humility (vv. 17-19)
 - a. Paul's view of himself a slave of Christ!
 - b. Bearing the burdens of others with tears!
 - c. Suffering hardship for Christ
- 2) Teaching without Compromise (vv. 20-21; 25-27)
 - a. No shrinking back on the tough stuff!
 - b. Teaching everywhere
 - c. Teaching everyone
 - d. Preaching the need for faith AND repentance
 - e. No blood on Paul's hands (cf. Ezekiel 33: 7-9)
- 3) Persevering in Faith (vv. 22-24)
 - a. Confidence in God's Providence
 - b. Suffering with purpose
 - c. Eyes fixed on the finish line

Application: Paul's example helps us to know what we should expect from our Church leaders. Although these instructions are primarily for Pastors/ Elders, the principles broadly apply to all of us.

II. Paul's Exhortation (vv. 28-32)

- 1) Pay Attention to Yourselves (v. 28)
 - a. Lifestyle (cf. 1 Tim 3:1-7, 4:16)
 - b. Doctrine
- 2) Pay Attention to the Flock (vv. 29-32)

- a. Pattern for Church Leadership
 - i. Plurality of Elders
 - ii. Three interchangeable terms for a single Church Office: 'Elder' (presbuteros) = 'Overseer/Bishop' (episkopos) = 'Pastor/Shepherd' (poimen)
- b. Job Description for the 'Pastors'
 - i. Care for the Flock (v. 28)
 - ii. Defend the Flock (vv. 29-31)
 - iii. Feed the Flock (v. 20)

Application: Pray regularly for the Pastors/ Elders of Rosedale Baptist Church we lead, feed and defend the Flock of God
