## Costly Discipleship (Part II) - Acts 21:1-26

Paul's journey to Jerusalem shows us what it means to count the cost of following Jesus Christ.
Paul models *costly discipleship* in two ways: 1)
His Inflexibility (vv. 1-16); 2) His Flexibility (vv. 17-26)

### II. Paul's Flexibility (vv. 17-26)

1) The Perennial Problem of Legalism

- a. <u>Legalism</u>: pursuing good works/ laws/ rules with the intention of earning God's favour
  i. God's Moral Law vs. Man-made Rules (Romans 6:1-2; *cf.* Colossians 2:16-23)
  - ii. Weak Conscience **vs**. Legalist (Romans 14:1-23; *cf*. Philippians 3:2-3)
- b. <u>Grace:</u> God's unmerited favour
- 2) Legalists within the Jerusalem Church had started a malicious rumour about Paul
  - a. The relationship of Gentiles to the ceremonial law (ie. circumcision) had been settled during the Jerusalem council (cf Acts 15)
  - b. The relationship of Jewish Christians to the ceremonial law was still a very hot issue!
    - i. Thousands of 'weaker brothers' in the Jerusalem Church felt that they should continue to follow the Law (v. 20)
    - A handful of 'Legalists' (aka Judaizers)
       within the Jerusalem Church wanted to
       discredit Paul's ministry among the Jews
- 3) James and the Elders suggest that Paul undergo a religious ritual to silence these rumours
  - a. Paul must have agonized over this decision!
    - i. Some scholars believe that Paul made a serious error in judgment here by giving in to the legalists

- ii. A better explanation is to see Paul acting here in the best interest of his brothers and sisters with weak consciences
- iii. Paul had no patience for legalists, but his guiding principle was always love for the 'weaker brother'
- b. "The truly emancipated soul is not in bondage to his own emancipation." - F.F. Bruce
  <u>Application:</u> Has our discipleship progressed to the point where we can place the interests of others before our own liberty? Can we love those who treat us with contempt?
