Warnings About Hell - Mark 9:42-50

I. An Announcement (vv. 30-32)

- 1) Second announcement of Jesus' death and resurrection (cf. 8:31, 10:30-32)
- 2) Each announcement is followed by a failure on the part of the Disciples
 - a. Disciples still do not understand what is about to happen to Jesus
 - b. Inclusion of these failures in Mark's Gospel speak strongly for the credibility of the Bible
- 3) Jesus' ministry is now focused on the final training of the Twelve Disciples (v. 30)
 - a. Miracles in the first half of Mark's Gospel serve to establish Jesus' identity
 - b. Miracles in the second half of Mark's Gospel serve to instruct His disciples

Application:

- Jesus' strong emphasis on proclaiming His death and resurrection should shape our emphasis in gospel proclamation. If we are not preaching Christ crucified we are not preaching the gospel!

II. An Argument (vv. 33-37)

- 1) Sinful Pride → Shameful Silence
 - a. Jesus is teaching about suffering and death, but the disciples are arguing about position and prestige!
 - b. Jesus' first lesson was on <u>faith</u> (vv. 14-29) but His second lesson is on <u>humility</u>
 - c. "Do not have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels." 2 Timothy 2:23
- 2) Principle of 'Greatness'

- a. In God's Kingdom the way to greatness is the way of service and humility
- b. Jesus demands and models perfect humility from His followers Phil 2:3-11; Mark 10:45
- 3) Object Lesson receiving a child
 - a. In Jesus' culture a child had no influence, greatness or social standing –Aramaic word for 'child'/ 'servant' is same
 - b. We should receive a 'child' just as we would receive the King Himself

Application:

- Remembering that Jesus is always listening to our conversations is a good reminder! Before you open your mouth to speak ask yourself: 'Would I say that that if Jesus were sitting right here beside me?'
- The gospel teaches humility "You are more sinful than you could dare to imagine and more loved and accepted than you could dare to hope." Tim Keller
- A sign of true humility is the willingness to serve people around you who are unable to pay you back.

III. An Admonishment (vv. 38-41)

- 1) John's Concern: unauthorized ministry
 - a. 'Not following us' (v. 38) cf. Num 11:26-29
 - b. Disciples are now acting like the Scribes
- 2) Jesus' Response
 - a. Clear line of division either 'for' or 'against'
 - b. Bottom line: Don't fight your own teammates!

Application:

- God's Kingdom is bigger than our denomination!
- A 'sectarian' attitude toward fellow believers is a very serious sin a manifestation of sinful pride
- We can't effectively fight the enemy if we're busy fighting each other Philippians 1:27-28
