Through Mary's Eyes - Part I - Luke 1:26-38

- I. Gabriel's Announcement (vv. 26-33)
- 1) The Angelic Messenger
 - a. Gabriel is one of 2 angels mentioned by name in the Bible
 - b. Most likely he is an 'archangel' like 'Michael' (Jude 9, *cf.* Luke 1:19)
 - c. Gabriel suddenly appears to Zechariah and Mary after 400 years of prophetic silence
- 2) The Setting of the Announcement
 - a. Striking contrast between the birth announcement of John the Baptist (vv. 5-25) and the birth announcement of Jesus
 - b. An obscure Galilean town: Nazareth
 - i. Town is not mentioned in Old Testament, Apocrypha, by Josephus, or in the Talmud
 - ii. Held in contempt by the Jews (John 1:46)
 - c. An obscure young woman: Mary or 'Miriam'
 - i. Engaged to be married to a man named Joseph (most likely 13-14 years old)
 - ii. Emphasis on her virginity (cf. Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:22-23)
 - iii. Poor (Luke 2:24, cf. Lev 12:6-8)
- 3) The Content of the Announcement
 - a. Mary is a recipient of God's grace ('favour')
 - i. Popular mistranslation from the Latin Vulgate: *"Hail Mary, full of grace"*
 - 1. Roman Church wrongly teaches that Mary is a <u>dispenser of God's grace</u>
 - 2. God's Word makes it clear that Mary was a <u>recipient of God's grace</u>
 - ii. Mary's low social standing magnifies the sovereign choice of God
 - 1. Unconditional Election

- 2. God chooses 'foolish' and weak things to confound the wise (1 Cor 1:27)
- b. An Unexpected Pregnancy
 - i. A Son named 'Jesus'
 - 1. Means "Yahweh is salvation"
 - Greek form of the Hebrew name 'Joshua' -the Bible hero who brought Israel into the Promised Land
 - ii. The Son of God (Isaiah 9:6)
- iii. The Davidic King or 'Messiah' (2 Sam 7)

II. Mary's Astonishment (vv. 29, 34-37)

- 1) Mary was "greatly troubled" (v. 29)
- 2) Mary was confused 'How will this be" (v. 34)
- 3) How did the Virgin Conception happen?
 - a. 'Overshadowing' of the Holy Spirit (*cf.* Exodus 40:34-35; Luke 9:34)
 - b. Mary's womb becomes a 'tabernacle' for God in human flesh!
- 4) Why was the Virgin Conception Necessary?
 - a. God's Word clearly teaches it!
 - b. Related to the unique, divine Sonship of Jesus
 "<u>therefore</u> the child to be born will be called holy -the Son of God" (v. 35)
 - c. "Nothing will be impossible with God." (v. 37)
- III. Mary's Answer (v. 38)
- 1) Mary responds to God in humble obedience
- 2) Mary counts the high cost of obedience
 - a. Possible divorce with Joseph
 - b. Disgrace of being viewed as an adulteress

Application:

- As Christians we should not worship, venerate, or pray to Mary but we should respect her as a model of humble, obedient faith in God

-Be in awe of the miracle and mystery of Christmas!

- Just like our salvation, Christmas begins with God's initiative and moves toward our response
