Reformation Day is a Protestant holiday celebrated on October 31st. It recognizes the day the German monk Martin Luther nailed his '95 Theses' to the door of the Wittenberg Church in 1517 – an act commemorated by historians as the official starting point of the Protestant Reformation. The main character in Reformation Day, however, is not Martin Luther - it's the Word of God! What Luther discovered as a monk is that for centuries the true teaching of the Bible had been hidden by layer upon layer of human tradition. That's what Reformation Day is about: it's about pulling back the covers and releasing the power of God's Word and the beauty and truth of the gospel of Jesus Christ. That's why we celebrate Reformation Day. God has saved us by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone, as revealed in Scripture alone, to the glory of God alone.

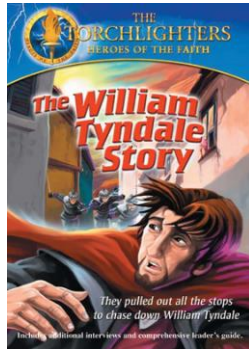
